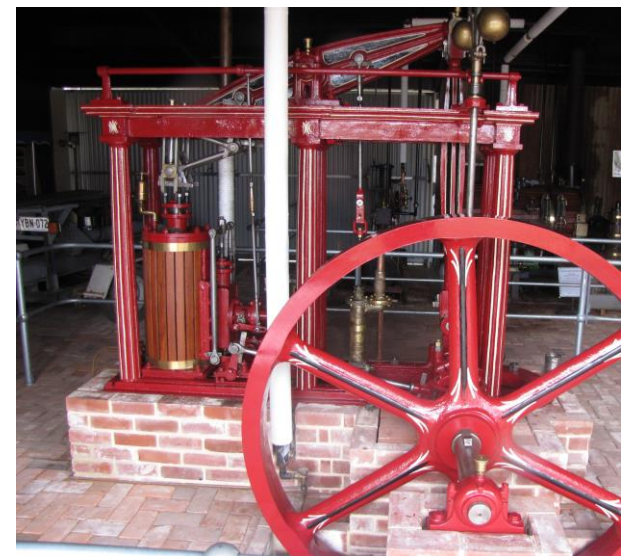
Rich River History comes to life at Mannum!

- ❖ Explore the "All Steamed Up" interactive display, be a River Boat Captain & steer along the Murray; study the river map; understand the science of steam power.
